Chaplain's Message

It's also a good opportunity to reach out to your children and grandchildren and remind them of the faith, and to encourage them to reach out to elderly of the community. Grand Knight's Report: WGK Mike Carter

- We're starting the new fraternal year – thank you all for all that you did last year, but it's time to start the year over
- The goal isn't a new plaque on the wall – it's to help our community
- Christmas in July – scheduled for this upcoming weekend – signup online or at the bar – serving food and beverages
- REBAR fundraising update - \$58,500. Last meeting, it was at \$45,000. If we get another \$10k like we did, month over month, we're going to get to our \$80k goal. We're getting into the more expensive part of the renovation. If you haven't donated yet, please consider giving us your financial support.
- The July/August Newsletter went out via email – there's a lot of information in there – Jared Hallal has taken it over from Keith Byerley – Thank you Keith for your years of service on it – We send the newsletter up to state and we have gotten a lot of good comments on it.
- Shout-out to one of our Knights, Charlie Medford, who works for Sprigler Garage

Door. As you know, we've been working on the garage at Trinity Cemetery. Charlie, on his own time, reframed the door and put up a new door with an electric opener, only charging Terry Popp \$250. If you see Charlie, give him a pat on the back. That's what it means to be a Knight

- Knobsfest is August 14th and 15th at SMK
- Council Room – getting an estimate tomorrow to put in a new ductless HVAC system. Estimating it will be roughly \$5000. If we can condition these lower rooms, add some paint and minor updates, these are perfect rooms to rent for a couple hundred dollars for small events like baby showers or bridal showers.
- Our gaming account continues to grow, but we need to give it away. Looking at the numbers, we've only given away 14% of the proceeds thus far. That number needs to be much higher. It's a charitable gaming account, the money shouldn't be sitting in there gathering interest. So as long as we can cover our Wheel of Cash outlays, we're going to start giving away more money this year and do better.

Deputy Grand Knight's Report: DGK Ron Webber

- REBAR rendering update – we went with LMA's renegotiated price of \$1800
- Polo shirts are in and ready for pickup
- Christmas in July – WGK will speak on that
- Anyone that's having issues with their security codes, let us know
- New Business:
 - REBAR – ready to start building walls next week on Tuesday
 - Approved purchasing of a filter for the fryer oil
 - Oil prices increased, so we looked to by a filter to increase the life of the oil
 - Discussed upgrades to the council room – WGK will talk about that
 - Tentative fish fry on August 20th for Back to School. Parochial school students get a free meal with ID. Going to recognize the baseball team that won state and other sports teams that deserve recognition
 - Going to have a fish fry on Wed, Aug 11th as well (drive through at lunch)

Treasurer's Report: Bro. John Kaiser

- The General Fund has \$18,363, the Gaming Fund has \$15,600 (up due to Wheel of Cash and pull-tabs) and the CBC Fund has \$55,000.
 - *(For new members, CBC stands for The Columbia Building Corporation which is a separate entity from Knights of Columbus 1221. Each 1221 member is also a shareholder in the CBC)*
- We've had a few repairs and expenditures in the past month (ice machine and repairs in the basement) that have drawing down our General Fund numbers.
- The mortgage currently stands at \$15,000
- Overall, the mortgage is going down and the accounts are going up, which is what we like to see
