#### Chaplain's Message

- A comment about the gospel for today: Jesus said to the crowds of men "Assuredly, I say to you, among those born of women there has not risen one greater than John the Baptist; but he who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he. And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force. For all the prophets and the law prophesied until John. And if you are willing to receive *it*, he is Elijah who is to come. He who has ears to hear, let him hear!"
- We don't think about violence in relation to the kingdom of heaven, it's often Jesus is the prince of peace and he comes to end violence, particularly to the oppressed. There's a call here for us to take the kingdom of heaven by violence. I think that one way of thinking about this is in terms of violence to ourselves, not to hurt or cause self-harm, but the reality that self-discipline requires sacrifice and suffering, a type of violence against the waywardness of our will. If and as we desire the kingdom of heaven, there's a place for us to take that to the violence of our own self-discipline, allowing ourselves to be transformed and conformed to Christ and his desires for our lives. Essentially we take up our cross and follow Him.
