## The Freedom to Bear Witness

Councils are once again encouraged to participate in the Fortnight for Freedom.

The Freedom to Bear Witness, which will be held from June 21 to July 4, 2016. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops asks people of all religious denominations to participate in this fifth annual period of prayer, fasting and advocacy to respond to our country's many threats to religious liberty.

Knights can prepare to involve their council and community in a variety of ways, including:

- Sponsoring a day of faith-based service within their communities.
- Hosting a panel discussion on current religious freedom issues and inviting a local or national figure to speak to your parish and council about religious liberty.
- Organizing Eucharistic adoration or leading a Eucharistic procession past important government or civic buildings in your community.
- Presenting a movie night for members. Show a film that highlights the importance of religious liberty, such as For Greater Glory, which tells the story of thousands of men and women who fought for religious freedoms in Mexico in the 1920s.
- Displaying religious freedoms signs.
