Chaplain's Encouragement

From the Catechism of the Catholic Church: "By calling God "Father", the language of faith indicates two main things: that God is the first origin of everything and transcendent authority; and that he is at the same time goodness and loving care for all his children. God's parental tenderness can also be expressed by the image of motherhood, which emphasizes God's immanence, the intimacy between Creator and creature. the language of faith thus draws on the human experience of parents, who are in a way the first representatives of God for man. But this experience also tells us that human parents are fallible and can disfigure the face of fatherhood and motherhood. We ought therefore to recall that God transcends the human distinction between the sexes. He is neither man nor woman: he is God. He also transcends human fatherhood and motherhood, although he is their origin and standard: no one is father as God is Father. Jesus revealed that God is Father in an unheard-of sense: he is Father not only in being Creator; he is eternally Father by his relationship to



his only Son who, reciprocally, is Son only in relation to his Father: "No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and any one to whom the Son chooses to reveal him." (CCC 239 & 240)

As is pointed out in the Catechism, God transcends human distinction. The Trinity, prior to the Incarnation of Jesus, is pure Spiritual being, neither male or female, complete and perfect. And yet, with the Incarnation, Jesus reveals God as Father and Himself as Son in the eternal love of the Spirit. This revelation is intended to draw us closer to God, to enhance our relationship, to make it more intimate, close, and loving. God the Father loves us as his sons through the Son and Spirit. And we are called to love God as Father with filial love.

This reality is personal for us, but is also practical for others. Have you ever paused as a man, a father, a Knight to realize that the way you live your masculinity and fatherhood is 1) supposed to be a reflection of God the Father in the world and 2) teaching others how to experience God as Father?

When others look at your fatherhood, do they see a sense of the holy, the divine, the selfless, unconditional love of the Father? Do your children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews, experience a strong tenderness, a firm flexibility, a forgiving truthfulness? Do they experience mercy, support, and affirmation? Not simply applause or attaboys, but authentic affirmation of the other as created other, as a son or daughter, made in the image and likeness of God. Do you affirm them in their masculinity and femininity? Are you modeling proper relational roles and boundaries for young men toward women, and for young women by men? Whether asked for or desired, this is in part our role as men, as dads, as fathers, as Knights. To reflect the Fatherhood of God. And as we do so, others are learning by analogy how God as Father relates to them. They are incorporating in their souls, their minds, their bodies the way to respond in love and openness to a God who desires a deep, lasting, eternal relationship with them, as much as with you.

This is a tall order, a burden, a cross even. But it is not done alone. It is done by God's Grace and by your very creation as a man. God has created you as such to be such, and so God will give you what you need, if you ask, to accomplish it. To do this well, we must first know ourselves as sons of God the Father. This is aided by prayer, Scriptures, Sacraments. It is aided by intentional cooperation with God's Grace to be who you were made to be – a man, a son, a father. May God the Father, help you, help us, now and forever. Amen.

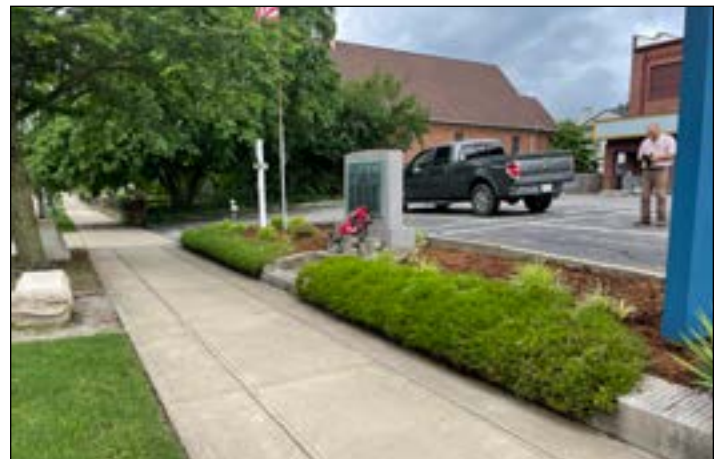

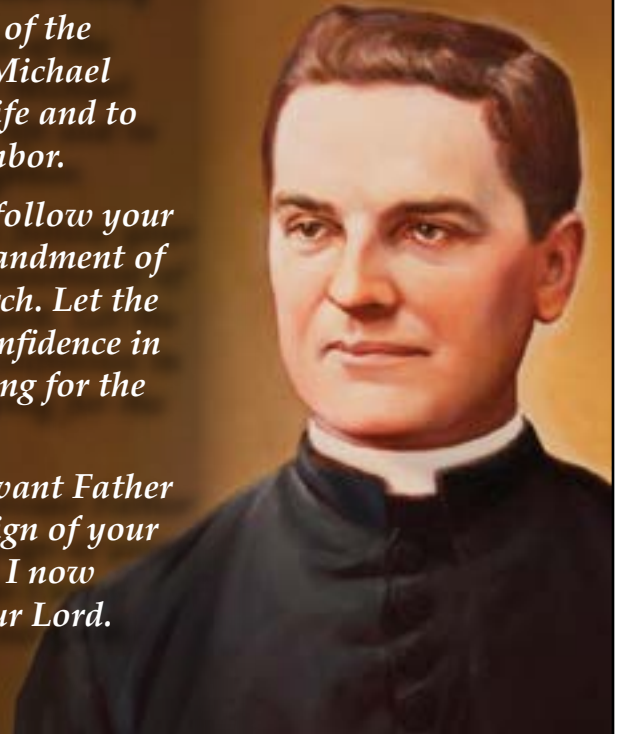
Prayer For The Canonization Of Father McGivney
